Great News CycleKnutsford have been awarded £4000 from The National Lottery "Awards for All." This is to fund Production of the Knutsford Cycling Map. The draft is now complete and we have approached a local firm to print it. The map should be available for next summer. There will be a run of 10,000 and it will be available free of charge. Not only will this map allow cyclists to plan their own safe route, but will be useful for pedestrians and other vulnerable road users such as mobility scooters.
