An Evening Illustrated Talk

Woodside Golf Club Wednesday, 8th March 2017 at 7.00 for 7.30

The Veteran-Cycle Club will be putting on the annual 2017 evening talk which is to be given by David Birchall, historian to the Anfield Bicycle Club - one of the earliest cycling clubs in Britain with an unbroken history stretching back into the 1880's.

David will describe the origins of the Anfield, its place in cycling history and he will illustrate his talk with rare archive photographs of the machines and riders - one of whom was the inspiration for the Tour de France!

As with previous talks at Woodside we are constrained by regulations relating to fire safety and licencing and so numbers attending are restricted to 70 and places will be initially allocated to V-CC members who confirm to me by February 20th that they will be attending. After that date remaining spaces will be offered to local CTC members and other local clubs.

Attendance by V-CC members is free, a nominal charge will be made to non V-CC persons joining us. There will be a mid-talk interval and sandwiches and chips will be served. Tea and coffee will be available and alcoholic or soft drinks can be purchased at the bar.

Numbered tickets will be allocated to keep a check on total attendees and to help with catering. Please contact me by 'phone or email and I will advise you of the ticket number allocated.
